



1985 First Nation by-laws were exempted from publication in the Canada Gazette

In response, First Nations leadership created the First Nations Gazette (FNG) to support their government's growing need to publish laws and notices. The FNG is an online service provided for First Nations and operated by the First Nations Tax Commission in partnership with the Native Law Centre of the University of Saskatchewan.



Available online with free access, the First Nations Gazette serves as the authoritative reference for First Nation laws and notices in Canada.

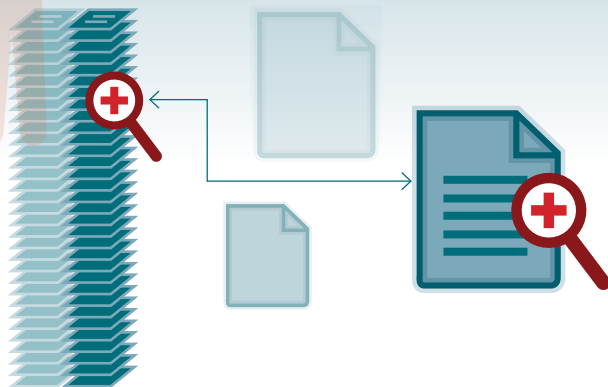
